The Events

Event 1: Treat Toss

Set up – Have a start line with the dog on the one side and the owner over the start line facing the dog.

Description - This event requires two humans: one to hold the leash and one to do the tossing! Dog is scored on how many catches made in 15 seconds!

Gold: Erik & Sneg

Silver: Kate & Gryphon

Bronze: Patricia & Bella

Event 2: Relay Retrieve

Set up – Have a start line and have a pile of balls that have been numbered about 6 feet from start line.

Description – This is a timed event (2 min) send dogs one at a time to a pile of balls that are numbered in the middle of the ring. Each dog retrieves one ball and races back to drop the ball behind the start line and then retrieves another until time runs out. The team with the most points at the end wins.

Event 3: Obstacle Course

Set up – Set up a course with a start line, a finish line, 6 cones about 6 feet apart for competitors to weave through; a tunnel and a hula hoop to go through.

Description – An individually timed event. Dogs manoeuvre through and around a variety of obstacles. The dog completing the course in the fastest time wins. Team loses 10 seconds for missing an obstacle.

Event 4: Golf

Set-up – A start line which is the tee and a finish which is the golf hole, with distractions along the way.

Description

Dogs will be placed in a down-stay at the tee. The handler can then try for a hole in one by calling their dog to them at the hole, or do shorter recalls, working their way to the hole. One point is added for each recall, and for each distraction the dog visits, such as obstacles on the course or other dogs or humans. The object is to have the lowest score at the end.

Event 5: Leave it

Set up – Dogs sit in front of a mat/plastic plate with their handlers by their side. Handlers tell their dogs to "Leave it". Treats are placed on the plate one at a time.

Description - In this test of obedience and will power, dogs must resist the lure of tasty treats and obey their handlers by "staying." Dogs sit in front of a paper plate with their handlers by their side. Handlers tell their dogs to "stay" by whatever means they choose. Treats, which include dog food, dog treats, cheese and pieces of hot dog, are placed on the plates one at a time. If a dog breaks and goes for the treats, he is excused from the competition. The final three dogs remaining win.

Event 6: Baseball

Set up – Have four bases set up as a baseball pitch with a behaviour to perform at each base.

Description - An individually timed event. Dog and handler must run the bases, stopping to successfully perform a different command before proceeding on to the next base. Commands may be repeated, but you lose 10 seconds. The dog getting around the bases (including home plate) in the fastest time is the winner.

Event 7: Marathon Sits

Set up – All dogs are placed into a sit by their owner at the same time.

Description- Marathon Sit will test your dog's obedience and concentration. After owners place their dogs in the sit position, various distractions will be presented to the dogs. The winners are the dogs that remain sitting the longest.

Bronze: Clint & Kobe

Event 8: Hot Dog Retrieve

Set up – Start line and hotdog line.

Description – To be the fastest dog to retrieve the hot dog out of the water and return to owner. Owner holds dog and runs towards hotdogs; dog eats hotdog and then returns to start line.
